4. Faith Sees Answers

Bible Texts: Proverbs 4:20-22; Hebrews 13:5, 6; 4: 14; Mark 11 :23

Central Truth: By continually looking at the Word, faith sees the answer.

Proverbs 4:20-22 NASB My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings. (21) Do not let them depart from your sight; Keep them in the midst of your heart. (22) For they are life to those who find them And health to all their body.

Matthew 8:17 NASB This was to fulfill what was spoken through Isaiah the prophet: "HE HIMSELF TOOK OUR INFIRMITIES AND CARRIED AWAY OUR DISEASES."

Mark 11:24 NASB "Therefore I say to you, all things for which you pray and ask, believe that you have received them, and they will be granted you.

Faith Contradicts Circumstances

Hebrews 13:5-6 NASB Make sure that your character is free from the love of money, being content with what you have; for He Himself has said, "I WILL NEVER DESERT YOU, NOR WILL I EVER FORSAKE YOU," (6) so that we confidently say, "THE LORD IS MY HELPER, I WILL NOT BE AFRAID. WHAT WILL MAN DO TO ME?"

Faith Says' the Answer

Hebrews 4:14 NASB Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.

Mark 11:23 NASB "Truly I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be taken up and cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that what he says is going to happen, it will be granted him.
